



ARE YOU A MODERN DAY ABRAHAM?

In Genesis 18: 1-3 we are told of three angels who visited Abraham. Some theologians compare these Angels to the Holy Trinity and God, Himself.

Several key things happened which parallel our modern day faith and culture. First, Sarah laughed when she heard that she in her old age would conceive a child and the immediate response from one of the Angels was, "Is anything too difficult for the Lord?" (Gen. 18:14). Note: Thousands of years ago, one pregnancy made Biblical history. Next Abraham negotiates with the Angels through a strategy of using God's mercy. He obtains a promise that the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah would not be destroyed if only 50 righteous people are found, then 45, then 40 and on and on until the Angels stop the negotiations at a minimum of 10 righteous people and a commitment the cities would not be destroyed. Ultimately, the angels allowed them to be spared as long as they did not look back at the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah. Lot's wife did look back and she was turned into a pillar of salt.

QUESTION: Is it possible that the work all of us are doing to save God's innocent unborn babies is now holding back the wrath of God just as in the days God judged Sodom and Gomorrah? Together let us pray that our efforts continue to save more innocent unborn each and every day. AMEN.
