SECOND APPARITION (CONT.) – FRONT OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION MEDAL

The golden ball vanished from Mary's hands and she extended her arms, the rays from her jeweled fingers flowing upon the globe beneath her feet. Under one foot was the serpent representing Satan. An oval formed around the Virgin, and written within it in letters of gold were these words: "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee." We at Several Sources ask you to contemplate this. If Mary was conceived without sin, then Mary must have had a soul at the moment of her conception. Therefore, does it not follow that each one of us is given a soul at the moment we are conceived? It is our faith and our belief that all preborn babies possess a soul from the moment of conception.
